2016 Parade Rules and Procedures

Friday, December 2, 2016

Parade Line-Up: Begins 7:00 pm for Check-In / Parade Begins: 8:30 pm

1. Parade will start at Central Baptist Church Center/Oak St. in the parking lot. It is approximately 2 miles in length.
 - a. Start by turning left off Oak Street onto Center going north.
 - b. Turn left onto Helgra – then left onto 13th Street
 - c. Continue past judging tables westbound on 13th Street
 - d. Disband at Houston Area Safety Council.
2. Personal vehicles will need to be parked in the same parking lot as the floats.
3. In order to avoid crowd build up and/or confusion during check in time, please inform all parade participants belonging to your organization of entrance, parking, and pick-up procedures.
4. **Check in time starts at 7:00 pm. All floats must be on site and checked in by 8:00 pm.**
5. Only one representative per entry needs to check in the night of the parade at the registration table. Here each representative will check in and then proceed to the line-up. It is imperative that floats park in the order they arrive. The order of parade line up will be determined based upon arrival. The earlier you arrive, the closer to the front of the line-up you will be.
6. The speed limit during the parade is 5 mph.
7. Candy may be released during the parade to the public only on one side of the road.
8. Do not have any standing participants on the float during the parade.
9. All entries must be “Family-Friendly” and suitable for all audiences.
10. Parade entries should not feature a traditional Santa as he will be featured as “Parade Marshall”.
11. All entries must be decorated.
12. Judging for all entries will take place at line up. Winners will be announced at 8:45 pm before the parade leaves the assembly parking lot. Judging Criteria is on: Lighting-creative use of illumination; Creativity-uniqueness and originality; Holiday Spirit- effective display of a theme or motif.
13. Do not stop your entry along the route unless you have an emergency. You may not stop your entry along the route to perform float repairs.
14. If music is played, it must be suitable for a family audience.
15. In case of rain, the parade will be cancelled. Please be listening to the announcements in the Activity Center and/or contact the center at 281-478-2049. You may also check our website: www.deerparktx.gov/reindeerpark and our facebook page at www.facebook.com/DeerParkTX.ParksandRecreation
