


# Regional History



## San Jacinto Battleground State Historic Site

Officially opened in 1907 as the first state park in Texas, the San Jacinto Battleground State Historic Site proudly preserves a monumental chapter in state, national and international history. The 1,200-acre site commemorates the Battle of San Jacinto, preserving the battleground on which Texan troops under General Sam Houston achieved the independence of Texas by defeating a Mexican Army led by General Lopez de Santa Anna on April 21, 1836. Today, the site includes the Battleground, the San Jacinto Monument, and the Battleship TEXAS. While at the site, visitors may take the elevator up to the Monument's Observation floor, 489 feet above the Battleground, and see the Houston Ship Channel from new heights! Then, tour the museum, watch the documentary "Texas Forever!! The Battle of San Jacinto" and pick up a souvenir. Finally, check out the 1,210-foot long trail and boardwalk, which features native prairie, tidal marsh and bottomland forest.

With walking tours, seasonal events and more, the San Jacinto Battleground State Historic Site is a perfect place for family time!

## San Jacinto Monument and Museum

The San Jacinto Monument was dedicated on April 21, 1939 to the "Heroes of the Battle of San Jacinto and all others who contributed to the independence of Texas." The monument includes a 570-foot shaft topped by a 34-foot star symbolizing the Lone Star Republic. Listed as the tallest stone column memorial structure in the world - even taller than the Washington Monument - the building was recognized by the American Society of Civil Engineers with the designation as a State and National Historic Structure.

The interior of the structure is operated by the San Jacinto Museum of History, a private, non-profit organization with collections spanning over 400 years of early Texas history.



## Battleship Texas State Historic Site

In 1948, the Battleship TEXAS became the first permanent battleship memorial museum in the U.S. On April 21, 1948, the U.S. Navy decommissioned and turned TEXAS over to the State of Texas to be a permanent memorial.

As the last remaining battleship that participated in both World War I and II, TEXAS is a testament to the dramatic changes that occurred in technology, warfare, and industry during the early twentieth century.

With a wide range of visitor tours and programs, including Hard Hat Tours, confined space rescue training, and even chances to sleep over on the ship, students and visitors alike will gain fascinating insight into what life was like as a sailor!

## San Jacinto Day Festival - Live the History!

Each year, over 20,000 visitors travel to the San Jacinto Monument and Museum for the San Jacinto Day Festival, which includes family entertainment, live history demonstrations, a children's area and Texas vendors. In the late afternoon, the largest battle reenactment in the state celebrates the 1836 Battle of San Jacinto. Free admission.

Following the battle of San Jacinto, General Sam Houston, David Burnet and the Texas Cabinet met at a nearby cabin took the Mexican General to a nearby cabin to draft the initial treaty documents securing Texas' independence from Mexico.

This cabin, the home of Dr. George Moffit Patrick, was located in Deer Park on Buffalo Bayou, and a historical representation of the structure stands in our Heritage Park. Because of these significant events, Deer Park holds the distinction of being the true "Birthplace of Texas."

### New historical features secured during 2017

The Historical Committee had a very busy year in 2017, with many accomplishments related to the 125th Anniversary Celebration and other significant milestones. In partnership with Dow Chemical and the Texas Historical Commission, the Historical Committee oversaw the movement of a Centennial Marker originally placed at the home of George Moffit Patrick from its location at Dow Chemical (formerly Rohm and Haas) to Heritage Park.

### Early Deer Park Graves

Around 1928, surveyors came across a headstone for siblings Mary Jackson and William Wilson. Around 1976, Shell contacted the Harris County Historical Commission and the City of Deer Park to make plans to move the gravesite.

The Commission gave Shell permission to move the gravesite and any remains from the site at Shell to Dow Park. A small cement casket of earth from the graves and the headstone were moved on March 7, 1977. It is Deer Park's oldest artifact and some historians believe it is the oldest marked grave in Harris County.

As of December 2017, the City was granted a Texas Historical Subject Marker for "Early Settlers in Deer Park." The marker, as well as the headstone, will be located in central Dow Park.

## Museum cabinets in Deer Park!

Throughout the City of Deer Park, visitors will find cabinets filled with historical documents, photos and items that shed light on the history of our area. The items on display were largely made available through citizen donations.

Cabinets are available for viewing at the Municipal Court/Theater Building (1302 Center Street), the Community Center (610 E. San Augustine), the Deer Park Public Library (3009 Center Street) and the Deer Park Visitors Center (203 Ivy Avenue).



The cabinets include photos, newspaper clippings and eight letters written by the City's founder, Simeon West, in the 1850s and 1860s - come see them today!

## Industrial Tank Murals

Visitors who travel along State Highway 225 through the Deer Park industrial region will be captivated by the beautiful artwork adorning the sides of select storage tanks lining the roadway. Each of the seven images tell a story about the hardships in the fight for Texas independence.


