General

Q. What day is the race and where will it be held?

A. Saturday, October 5, 2019 at the Deer Park Community Center located at 610 E. San Augustine. Course map may be printed at our website: www.deerparktx.gov/parksandrec

Q. What time does the race start?

A. 10K starts at 7:30 am. 5K starts at 8am. Monster Mile starts at 9am

Q. Where can I pick up my T-shirt and participant packet if I have already registered online?

Q. Will there be anything else at the event besides the race?

A. Yes. There will be food, music, and live entertainment before and after the race. We have some wonderful companies sponsoring our event. Whataburger. Q. Will the race be timed?

A. Yes, Run Houston will be here this year to chip our race.

Q. Where are the water stations, aid stations and restrooms?

A. There will be several hydration stations located throughout the racecourse. Additionally, there will be water and Gatorade at the award area. We will have Deer Park Volunteer Fire Department and EMS at the



start/finish line. They will also be following the runners through the course. Restrooms are located inside the Deer Park Community Center.

Q. Am I able to register on Race Day?

A. Yes, 10K and 5K registration will be open from 6:30am – 7:30am and Monster Mile from 6:30am – 8:30am. Register inside the Deer Park Community Center, Front Office.

Q. Are there prizes awarded to the top runner in multiple age groups?

A. Yes, individual awards to the top male/ female runner for each the age division.
