AN UPDATE ON THE DEER PARK ENERGY TRANSFER PIPELINE FIRE EVACUATED ZONE

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Deer Park, TX – September 17, 2024 – 2:45 PM

The City of Deer Park is continuing to monitor the pipeline fire on Spencer Highway.

Harris County Hazmat and the Deer Park Volunteer Fire Department (DPVFD) are preparing to enter homes in the East Meadow area.

Harris County Hazmat will initially enter the homes to conduct air quality monitoring. Once it's deemed safe, the DPVFD will enter the neighborhood to conduct an initial search of the homes and then proceed with a secondary, more thorough, search of the homes.

The evacuated zone has been condensed to the footprint of the attached map. If you are a property owner within the red coloration on the map, please do not attempt to enter the area. Homes in the area may still be without power.

Roadway Information:

- East Blvd open to Spencer Hwy southbound
- Canada Blvd open to Spencer Hwy northbound
- Spencer Highway is open eastbound from East Blvd
- Spencer Highway is open westbound from Fernlock Dr
