**DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR HURRICANCE LAURA**

WHEREAS, Hurricane Laura poses a threat of imminent disaster, including widespread and severe property damage, injury, and loss of life due to widespread flooding, storm surge, and damaging winds within the City of Deer Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster for a hurricane emergency is hereby declared for the City of Deer Park, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster for hurricane emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Deer Park, Texas.
3. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster for hurricane emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of local state of disaster activates the City emergency management plan.
5. Any individual, group of individuals, or property subject to a Local Health Authority Order restricting the movement of that individual or group of individuals of restricting movement to, from, or within that property, shall limit ingress and egress and take such measures as specified by that Local Health Authority Order.
6. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
